School Logo Blue Sweatshirt/Logo Cardigan	Plain White Blouse or Polo Top	Grey/black Trousers/Shorts or Grey Skirt	Grey Pinafore or Gingham Dress or Culottes Dress (summer)	Black School Shoes / Back Strap Sandals

Boys and Girls

- Ear Piercing - children are ONLY allowed 1 small stud per ear (removed for PE)
- Plain Black/grey or white socks ONLY

PE Kit - Both Girls and Boys

Plain White T-Shirt (no logos or designs)	Plain, Elasticated PE Shorts (no buttons or zips)	Outdoor Trainers	Swimming costume, hat, goggles (if needed) and towel

Optional Winter PE Items

Track Suit / Jogging Suit	Sweatshirt (not hoody)

The items on the PE Kit are quite specific for safety reasons - button/zips etc can cause nasty injuries both for the wearer and other - particularly during competitive sports. Earrings need to be removed for PE or taped over.

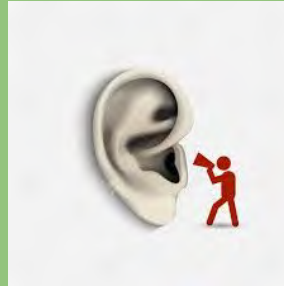
