Dear Parents,

The Coastal Club has been open now since Easter and has proved to be particularly popular during the first half of the club's opening time of 3.20-4.30, averaging around 9 children per night. However the second half from 4.30-6.00 is attended by, on average 2 children and not on every night.

I did state that we would review the financial viability of the club at May half-term and we have concluded that the second session, although valuable to those families and children, is not sustainable. We are not allowed by Norfolk County Council to operate at a loss. Breakfast club is growing in numbers and will continue to operate as it does now. The revised times for the after school setting will be as follows from Monday 10th June;

3.20 - 4.30	£3.00	NOTES It is possible for your child to attend a 3.20-4.15 teacher-run club or outsider provider club ie latin, dodgeball etc but if you intend your child to continue onto the 4.30 after school child care club then the full £3 charge will apply to this session, as we need to cover staffing costs.
4.30 - 5.00	£2.00	A fixed £2 charge will be for this session regardless of the pick up time.

Payment for sessions needs to be made in advance through the School Money system - see the Prospectus for more details or call the school office and speak to Mrs Gent.

The indoor sessions will be interspersed with some physical activity, outside if the weather permits.
