You will already be aware of the news confirming that Coastal Together will become a full federation from 1st September. In preparation for this I would like to share the following information with you regarding the structure of the schools at MIJS

From September Miss Howett will become Head of Schools, leading Mundesley 'primary' school. This is part of the natural progression of the infant and junior schools working seamlessly together over the last 6 years. Miss Croft was recently appointed Head of Teaching and Learning, Standards and CPD across the six schools of the federation. Her time will be split 50:50 across the two federations of Coastal and Together. Mr Hopkins remains Deputy Executive Head and will be in charge when I am based at the Together Schools, which will be for 50% of my time.

We will be welcoming Miss Gray and Miss Pettifer from September, who will be joining the teaching team.
