Uniform Reminders and Winter Coats

Welcome back to school. As you know in the weekly Head of School update at the end of last term we provided a reminder regarding slippers. Please note that slippers are part of our uniform. Before the children wore slippers, during the winter months each year they were required to bring in alternative shoes or wellies in order to access the field/play equipment. Traditionally this is our wettest and coldest time of the year and as slippers are now a part of our uniform, this has made things much easier. Unfortunately children will not be able to play on the field or play equipment without any slippers to change into due to the mud being brought into school.

Uniform: Please ensure that your child wears the school uniform as outlined. This includes ensuring children are wearing the correct PE kit on the children's PE days.
